Hi,

Was hoping you would be willing to sign our petition. On Friday, as a result of the government's refusal to bargain with us in a serious manner, and as a result of our CEO Lee Doney making public statements in the media that there is no staffing problem in the ambulance service, our union gave all of us direction to stop working shifts above and beyond our normal, scheduled work load (ie. OT shifts, short notice coverage shifts, etc.). As of Saturday night a Supreme Court injunction has been issued ordering the union to rescind this direction.
